

Village that's a model of Self Help

- Villagers conducted a water audit in the year 2002 and dug a borewell in 2003 after pooling in Rs. 50,000/-
- Six Women Self Help Groups have been formed with more than two hundred women involved in it to facilitate micro credit for their requirements.
- Living conditions of the village have been improved by a joint efforts of the residents of the village.

After the village has become clean and there is enough water, the youth in about 85 per cent of the families have gone back to the traditional agriculture. Those who hold private jobs now commute from the village. And the youth are also coaching students from the village so that they can do better in life.
